Humpback and blue whales, as well as white-beaked dolphins, harbor porposes. seals and basking sharks during a whale watching cruse from Hûsavik.

We complete our journey through loeland with stops along the Tjörnes peninsula, Asbyrgi caryon and at Dettifosa, Europe's mightiest waterfall, located in the northern part of Vatnajokull National Park, and spend a final afternoon scaling in the gem-colored gosthermal waters of the Blue Lagoon.
